WGS 84 E 0360939 N 5486468	49° 30.893 82° 55.270	*Travel Hwy 11 to the community of Opasatika and find Crow Creek road, west of the village. *Drive for approximately 5.3km on the Crow Creek road. *When you arrive at the intersection of Crow Creek and Fergus roads, stop at the "STOP" sign. *Walk approx. 70m West on Fergus road. *From there, the cache is approximately 50m in the bush, in a southwest direction. If you see a white picket fence enclosure, you are almost there.	Regular	Sunday Driver, introductory, family
